Christian Character Award

The Christian Character Award is the highest recognition awarded by the Academy. It is recognition of achievement for the Jr. High or High School (ages 13 & up) student who exemplifies a Godly witness, testimony and example in their spiritual and academic life. This award consists of:

- A very nice trophy that can be cherished as a reminder to maintain a consistent example.
- A \$50 cash gift.
- A news-release announcement sent to the student's church for including in a Sunday bulletin.
- An announcement and recognition on the school's website.

Requirements for Christian Character Award

1. Be faithful to the services of your church.

This means that, as a habit, you attend each of the regularly scheduled services of your church, and any revivals, Bible-Conferences, etc.

2. Be involved in a ministry of your church.

You are involved and committed to serving in some ministry of your church. For example, you sing in the choir, play an instrument, teach a class, attend soul-winning visitation, work in deaf ministry, etc. To meet this qualification, you must have a *Christian Service Report* completed and signed by your pastor. The Director must approve this report.

3. Memorize a chapter of the Bible (of at least 25 verses) from the following list: You may combine any of the chapters listed below for the twenty-five verse minimum

• Job 23	• Psalm 73	•Proverbs 3	• Isaiah 6	• Isaiah 53	• Isaiah 54
• Matt 7	• Luke 16	• John 14	• John 15	• Romans 1	• II Timothy 2
• Rev. 21	• Galatians 5	• Jude 1	• Hebrews 11		

or, you may memorize the Book of First Timothy and receive 3000 bonus merits.

All verses must be quoted without any help of the Supervisor, Director, Monitor, Principal or Administrator.

4. Maintain at least A-B Honor Roll average status for the year.

You must demonstrate the Christian quality of giving your best. This is reflected in your work and study habits.

5. Maintain a Godly example.

Your Christian testimony must reflect the convictions and standards of the Word of God. You must maintain your example by abiding by rules and guidelines of the school handbook,

without murmuring, arguing, griping or complaining. For example, you must not listen to worldly music (as defined in the handbook). You must demonstrate a Godly example at school, and away from school.

- 6. All work, for your level, must be completed by the final day of the fourth quarter.
- 7. Must not have received excessive detention time.
- 8. Must submit a written testimony and self-evaluation of your spiritual development over the past year. This report must be submitted to the Principal's Office no later May 8, 2020.
